Environmental Disturbance Application 22-02:

Chris McKennan and Katherine Hines 140 Lakeside Drive Construction of a New Single-Family Residence

David and Michelle Trueba 141 Old Mill Road Construction of a New Single-Family Residence

The EAC recommends approval of Environmental Disturbance Application 22-03 by Borough Council as submitted, which would include a waiver of any requirement for the submission of a geotechnical report and, contingent upon ACCD submission and approval, the execution of a Stormwater Management Operations and Maintenance Agreement, and with a strong recommendation for the planting of additional canopy trees and cooperative planting along the border of the neighboring property.

Stream Renaming

On February 25, 2022, an email was sent to O'Hara Township from the U.S. Board on Geographical Names outlining the new Federal Government's procedures for addressing Squ** names nationwide. Unfortunately, this email was not received by O'Hara Township. The deadline for public and tribal comment submissions to the Derogatory Names Task Force was Monday, April 25, 2022. Sycamore Run was the only viable option due to conflicts with other local stream names or accuracy with mileage from the Allegheny and Monongahela Rivers confluence.

O'Hara Township and the Borough of Fox Chapel submitted the name Sycamore Run to the Board on Geographical Names before April 25, 2022.

NEW BUSINESS

Resolution No. 672

Adopt Resolution No. 672 that will allow the Borough of Fox Chapel to request a Watershed Restoration and Protection Program grant in the amount of \$300,000 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for the Fox Chapel Borough PRP Stream Improvement Project.

Ordinance No. 719

Enact Ordinance that amends the sewage rates for Allegheny Valley Joint Sanitary Authority. The total rate will now be \$10.05 and will affect 40 residents of the Borough. This increase of \$4.82/1,000 gallons is necessary due to the mandated plant expansion and conveyance system upgrade project for AVJSA.
