# 2024 Ford F550 Up-Fit Package

#### 2024 Ford 250 Super Duty 4X4 SRW (Super Cab Pick-Up)

# Allegheny County Municipal Winter Traffic Services Agreement

#### Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Green Light Go Program

The Borough was awarded \$204,919 for updated signal equipment at Fox Chapel Road and Field Club Road. The Borough's Capital Reserve Fund contains the 50% match which is required for the grant.
