Arrest Made in Five Residential Burglaries in Fox Chapel, O'Hara

Allegheny County – A collaborative effort between local law enforcement and county police detectives has led to the identification and arrest of a suspect connected with five burglaries which occurred in Fox Chapel Borough and O'Hara Township over a year's time. Andrew Clinton, 20, of the Squirrel Hill neighborhood of the City of Pittsburgh was arrested yesterday, April 4, 2022 and charged with multiple counts including burglary, criminal attempt burglary, theft, receiving stolen property, and criminal mischief.

On March 28, 2022 at 8:00 p.m., Fox Chapel Police received a report of a burglary in the 100 block of Field Club Road. The methods used were consistent with several other residential burglaries which had occurred over the prior year in Fox Chapel and O'Hara. The departments requested the investigative assistance of the County Police General Investigations Unit.

On February 7, 2021, two burglaries had been reported in the 400 block of Wickford Drive in O'Hara and an attempted burglary was reported in the 100 block of Bentley Dive, also in O'Hara. On August 6, 2021, Fox Chapel police responded to a burglary in the 700 block of Waldheim Road. The methods used in each of the burglaries was consistent. Cash, jewelry, sports memorabilia, stereo equipment, a lamp, and firearm were just some of the items reported as stolen in the burglaries.

In its investigation, ACPD detectives were advised that earlier in the day on March 28, at approximately 6:20 a.m., officers had responded to Field Club Road for a vehicle stuck in the mud. That vehicle had been driven by 20-year-old Andrew Clinton. As a result, detectives began to look at Clinton more closely. On April 4, 2022, detectives obtained a search warrant for his residence. Assisted by Pittsburgh Bureau of Police, ACPD detectives recovered some of the stolen items and subsequently obtained an arrest warrant for Clinton. He was arrested earlier this morning and transported to the Allegheny County Jail for arraignment.
